Aidyn Mae Gottlieb was born with an extremely rare, debilitating neurological disorder called FOXG1 Syndrome. Most patients, including Aidyn, are unable to walk, talk, or eat unassisted and suffer from a wide range of life altering symptoms including: visual impairment, uncontrolled movements, sleep disorders, seizures, extreme unprovoked irritability, acid reflux, and more.

The FOXG1 gene plays a critical role in brain development because it regulates several other genes in the brain. When a person does not have the right amount of the protein created by this gene, the whole body is impacted and prevents normal development. The Aidyn Mae Hope Fund is sponsoring research into a promising Gene Replacement Therapy which has already demonstrated results with mutated mice, and for which additional funding is necessary to advance these efforts into FDA-approved human clinical trials.
